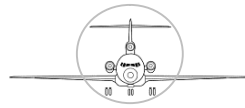

He successfully passed the National Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Exam-first time candidate.

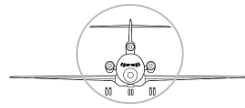
